- no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains

Moni Malawi will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008, and 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008. The Government will pay to Moni Malawi an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011 – this transitional relief for the Charity does not affect your personal tax position.

**If you pay income tax at the higher rate**, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
